Terms and Conditions "Abenteuer im Wald Kenzingen"

- 1. All participants must read these Terms and Conditions before entering the forest climbing garden. By signing this document, they confirm that they have read and accept these Terms and Conditions. The parents/guardians of under-aged participants are solely responsible for providing supervision during their visit and for accompanying under-aged participants while in the forest climbing garden.
- 2. All users enter this facility at their own risk.
- The operator will not be liable in the event of injury caused by screw connections, steel cables, rope sheaves, wooden splinters, parts of the exercises, branches, pathless terrain etc., or damage e.g. to clothing, mobile phones, cameras etc. This does not affect the operator's liability in the event of negligence.
- 3. This facility is suitable for all visitors of at least 1.40 m in height who are not suffering from illness or a mental or physical disability that could endanger their own health and well-being, or that of other persons, while in the climbing garden. Children and young persons up to 18 years of age must be accompanied when climbing by a parent/guardian. The parent/guardian may present a declaration of consent stating that the forest climbing garden may be visited without the attendance of the parent/guardian. Participation is then at the user's own risk. Persons who have consumed alcohol or who are under the influence of drugs are not permitted to enter the forest climbing garden.
- 4. Visitors to the forest climbing garden are not permitted to take with them any items that could endanger the participant or any other persons, e.g. by said item falling or being dropped (bags, rucksacks, jewellery, watches, mobile phones, cameras etc.). Long hair must be tied back appropriately (hairnets, hair ties etc.) to eliminate the risk of if becoming tangled up in any of the elements, steel cables, exercises and the rope sheave.
- 5. The operator's instructions and decisions are binding. In the event of contravention or infringement of the operator's instructions, the individuals involved may be excluded from the forest climbing garden without reimbursement of their entrance fee. In the event of contravention or infringement of the operator's instructions, the operator will not accept liability for any resulting damages.
- 6. <u>All participants must attend the safety briefing before entering the forest climbing garden.</u> All loan equipment (helmet, belt etc.) must be used in accordance with the instructions given in the safety briefing. It may not be transferred to others, and is not to be removed whilst inside and using the forest climbing garden. It must be returned no later than 3 hours after issue. In the event of this time being exceeded, there will be a charge of 3.00 euros for each half-hour or part thereof irrespective of the discounts given in the price list or the age of the participants.</u>
- 7. The operator reserves the right to close the facility or parts of the facility for safety reasons (fire, storm, thunderstorm, rain etc.) as and when necessary. The entrance fee will not be reimbursed. Should the guest choose to end the visit to the forest climbing garden earlier, s/he will not be entitled to any reimbursement, full or partial, of the entrance fee.
- 8. The individual exercises between the tree platforms may only be used by one person at a time. No more than three people may wait at the tree platforms.
- 9. <u>Users must always brake on the Flying Foxes</u> in order to prevent impact with the trees and the landing platform. Protective gloves must be worn. The cable slides are not to be used until the user is certain that there are no persons in the vicinity of the landing area.
- 10. Users are to secure themselves with the karabiners. Parents must check that their children are suitably secured. The safety karabiners must always be hooked into the red safety rope or the rope of the Flying Fox; the two safety karabiners must not be unhooked at the same time.
- 11. Should any of the clauses in these T&Cs be invalid, they will be substituted by the corresponding legal regulation. This will not affect the validity of the remaining clauses.
